## COACHING DIRECTOR'S REPORT - RON GAUCI

Well the 2003 home and away series has come to a close. Well done to all – you have done Fitzroy proud this year. Fitzroy will have teams represented in the finals for each age group from U10 to U14. Our representation in the finals series has grown from 4 teams in 2001, to 5 in 2002 and now 6 in 2003. This is an excellent performance. We had four of our teams finish in the top two positions and we won 97 games for the year compared with 93 last year and 88 the year before. This is a long way forward of our first year when our club kicked a single goal for the whole season. Our match success rate has also improved from 46% in 2001 to 48% in 2002 and 53% in 2003. Each team experienced the opportunity to sing the club song on at least one occasion this year – well done. The other interesting metric is indicated on the table below in terms of our rankings against other Clubs within the competition. The table below shows the Top 15 (of 25) Clubs in the YJFL, by teams in the finals this year. We have climbed this ladder to be in third position – our best position yet. Considering that we only fielded 11 teams this year, to have 6 of these experience finals football is an excellent achievement.

### **FEES - 2003**

We have a 75% rate of fees in as at 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2003.

As usual the younger age groups have done best, with some teams already returning 100%.

Unfortunately, this year the Colts (Under 17s) has been very disappointing with only 6 out of 24 players having paid **OR** contacted the club with enquiries about receiving a subsidy and/or deferred payment.

As most people would be aware the club is happy to subsidise players **if** we are contacted – either directly to the treasurer or secretary, or via your team manager to discuss the issue.

If we have not heard from parents or players in relation to unpaid 2003 fees *OR* jumpers are not returned those players will be ineligible to play for FJFC in season 2004.

## FJFC PLAYER AGE POLICY

It is the policy at FJFC that all players play in their age group.

Players may spend 2 years at Under 10 level as players must be turning 9 years old as a minimum entry age into the Under 10s in their first year of playing.

At Under 17 Colts, players may also spend 2 years in this age level, as this is the next available age group after Under 15s.

The age level is determined by the calendar year, Jan 1<sup>st</sup> to Dec 31<sup>st</sup>. For example, if you are turning 11 in 2004, you will be in Under 11s for the 2004 footy season.
